



## **Four State QRP Group Scholarship Application**

**The 4SQRP Amateur Radio Scholarship is awarded annually under the following provisions:**

- 1. A sum of \$500.00, subject to available funds, is provided by Four State QRP Group. Up to four (4) scholarships will be awarded each year.**
- 2. The selection process will include reviewing individual applications by the 4SQRP Board of Directors Scholarship Committee.**
- 3. In order to be eligible for the scholarship, an applicant must:**
  - 1. Be a member in good standing of Four state QRP Group or be a family member of a licensed amateur radio operator. Children and grandchildren qualify**
  - 2. Hold a current valid Amateur Radio License, any class, issued by the US FCC. Applicant may qualify without one.**
  - 3. Plan to be a full-time student (at least 12 credit hours if undergraduate, or equivalent as a graduate student).**
  - 4. Currently have a cumulative high school or college GPA of at least 3.00 out of 4.00, or equivalent college entrance requirements.**
  - 5. Plan to enroll, or be enrolled, in a 2 or 4-year degree program, or a graduate degree program, at an accredited college or university or attending an accredited trade school. The field of study must be beneficial to the Amateur radio hobby. Preference may be given to electronics, computer programming and emergency management studies.**
  - 6. Be a U.S. citizen.**
  - 7. Retirees reentering an educational program are welcome to apply.**

**The scholarship funds will be paid in early May for summer semester and August for fall semester directly to the applicant upon proof of acceptance to the educational program.**

**The scholarship will be null and void if not used within fifteen months of the notification of the winner.**
